

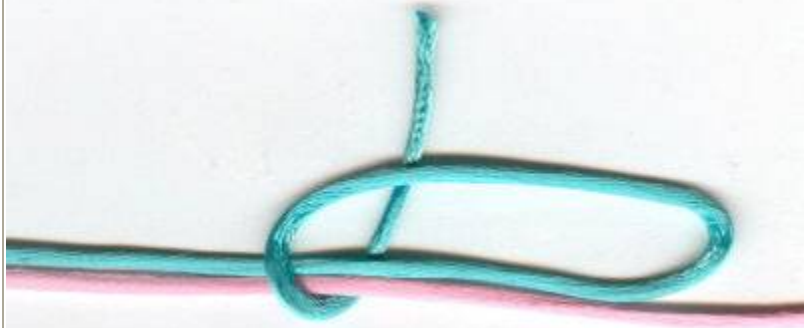
Cord Tying

This technique makes a pretty adjustable knot for necklaces. It is sometimes called a Triple Connection Knot.

1. Hold one cord against the other. Double the end over.



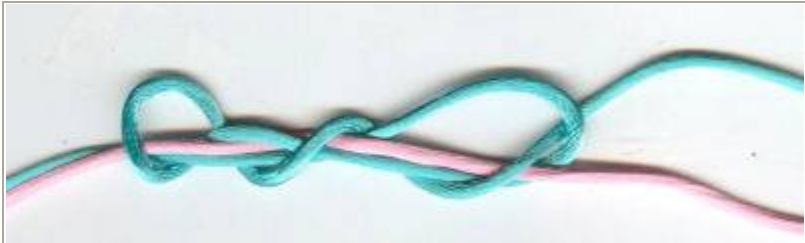
2. Loop the end around both cords.



3. Loop the end around both cords two times and bring the end strand through the original loop.



4. Begin to pull both ends of the working cord in opposite directions.



5. Pull until the knot is secure. Repeat with the other strand.
